A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to reevaluate the structure and operations of the executive branch in order to develop methods of effecting greater efficiency and cost savings.

WHEREAS, the first step-down in funding under the Compact with the United States of America is eminent; and 3 WHEREAS, the Congress is desirous of seeing positive steps being taken by all the branches of government to reduce waste and 5 needless duplication of functions and services; and WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of Congress during oversight and appropriation hearings with the executive branch that there appear to be areas where consolidation of functions and operations would permit a reduction in funding requirements while at 10 the same time providing the same level of services; now, therefore, 11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1991, that the President 12 is hereby respectfully requested to review and reevaluate the current 13 structure and operations of the executive branch in order to develop 14 15 methods of effecting greater efficiency and cost savings; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution 16 be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia 17 18 and the Budget Officer for the National Government. 19 Date: 6-14-91 Introduced by: Sedley Killion 20 21 22 23 24
