## A RESOLUTION

To ratify the Constitution of the Asia-Pacific Telecommunity.

- 1 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 2 has recently ratified the constitutive documents of the
- 3 International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and the
- 4 International Telecommunication Satellite Organization
- 5 (INTELSAT), with a view to assumption of full membership in
- 6 these organizations by the Federated States of Micronesia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 8 is currently finalizing negotiations to achieve the goal of
- 9 assuming full membership in the ITU and INTELSAT; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 11 has recently supported the establishment of a new Division of
- 12 Communication in the Department of Transportation and
- 13 Communication to carry out the vital work of radiofrequency
- 14 management and to fulfill vital international legal obligations
- 15 for radiofrequency management; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the new staffs of the Division of Communication
- 17 will have an increased and continuing need for training and for
- 18 exposure to the protocols of international organizations and to
- 19 the national and international personnel involved in
- 20 radiofrequency management in the Asia-Pacific Region; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the Asia Pacific Telecommunity (APT), along with
- 22 the South Pacific Telecommunications Program and the ITU, is one
- 23 of the three preeminent international telecommunications
- 24 organizations in this region of the world; and
- 25 WHEREAS, the APT is established as a regional

1 telecommunication organization in conformity with Article 32 of

- 2 the International Telecommunication Convention of the ITU, and
- 3 is the primary provider of technical training, consultancies,
- 4 and training fellowships in the Asia-Pacific Region; and
- 5 WHEREAS, contributions to the APT by developed, metropolitan
- 6 countries make it possible for smaller countries, such as the
- 7 Federated States of Micronesia, to join APT for minimum annual
- 8 dues of only about \$3,125 per year; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the funding, nature and purpose of APT to provide
- 10 training and developmental assistance to small, developing
- 11 countries means that the benefits of membership outweighs the
- 12 cost of membership, in that at least five full training
- 13 fellowships, including travel and per diem, are given to small
- 14 developing countries each year, each one of which is worth more
- 15 than the cost of membership; and
- 16 WHEREAS, membership in the APT is open to all members of the
- 17 United Nations without discrimination; now, therefore,
- 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh Congress of the Federated
- 19 States of Micronesia, Third Special Session, 1992, that pursuant
- 20 to section 2(b) of article IX of the Constitution of the
- 21 Federated States of Micronesia, the Congress hereby ratifies the
- 22 Constitution of the Asia-Pacific Telecommunity; and
- 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon receipt of this resolution
- 24 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia shall lodge,
- 25 as soon as possible, an instrument of ratification with the
