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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-89, as amended, by further amending section 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-99, 5-126, 6-8, 6-16 and 6-87, for the purpose of modifying the use of funds appropriated for public projects in the Mortlocks, Chuuk State, by further amending section 8, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-99, 7-2 and 7-56, for the purpose of changing the allottee of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 5-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-99, 5-126, 6-8, 6-16 and 6-87, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Mortlocks public projects. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1989, for the purpose of funding certain public projects in the Mortlock Islands, Truk State. The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

9 Section 2. Section 8 of Public Law No. 5-89, as amended by
10 Public Laws Nos. 5-99, 7-2 and 7-56, is hereby further amended to read
11 as follows:


12 "Section 8. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
13 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
14 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
15 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
16 Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds appropriated
17 under sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act shall be the Governor of
18 Truk State, except for the funds appropriated by sub-paragraph
19 (1)(d) of section 1 for which the allottee shall be the Truk
20 State Congressional Delegation; by sub-paragraph (2) of section
21 1 for which the allottee shall be the Executive Director of
22 the Truk Maritime Authority; and by sub-paragraph (3) of
23 section 1 for which the allottee shall be the Executive
24 Director of the Truk Organization of Community Action. The
25 allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 4 and 7 of

1 this act, under subsections (5) and (6) of section 5 of this
2 act, and under subsections (4)(a)(i), (4)(b)(i), (4)(c)(i) and
3 (4)(d)(i) of section 6 of this act shall be the Chairman
4 of the Truk State Congressional Delegation. The allottee
5 of ~~the~~ all other funds appropriated under ~~sub-paragraphs (1)~~
6 ~~and (4)~~ of section 5 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks
7 Development Authority. ~~The allottees of the funds appropriated~~

10 ~~the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (3) of section 5~~

12 The allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (1)
13 and subsections (4)(a)(ii), (4)(b)(ii), (4)(c)(ii), (4)(d)(ii),
14 and (4)(e) of section 6 of this act shall be the Hall Islands
15 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated
16 under sub-paragraphs (2) and (5) of section 6 of this act shall
17 be the Weito Islands Development Authority. The allottee of
18 the funds appropriated under sub-paragraphs (3) and (6) of
19 section 6 of this act shall be the Pattiw Islands Development
20 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
21 sub-paragraph (7) of section 6 of this act shall be the Board
22 of Directors of the Nomwin Co-op. Each allottee shall be
23 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof
24 as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified
25 in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of

1 the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate
2 funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse until expended."

3 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
5 law without such approval.
