A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-89, as amended, by further amending section 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-99, 5-126, 6-8, 6-16 and 6-87, for the purpose of modifying the use of funds appropriated for public projects in the Mortlocks, Chuuk State, by further amending section 8, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-99, 7-2 and 7-56, for the purpose of changing the allottee of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

11	as follows:
12	"Section 8. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
13	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
L4	managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
L5	applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
L6	Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds appropriated
۱7	under sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act shall be the Governor of
18	Truk State, except for the funds appropriated by sub-paragraph
L9	(1)(d) of section 1 for which the allottee shall be the Truk
20	State Congressional Delegation; by sub-paragraph (2) of section
21	1 for which the allottee shall be the Executive Director of
22	the Truk Maritime Authority; and by sub-paragraph (3) of
23	section 1 for which the allottee shall be the Executive
4	Director of the Truk Organization of Community Action. The
:5	allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 4 and 7 of

this act, under subsections (5) and (6) of section 5 of this act, and under subsections (4)(a)(i), (4)(b)(i), (4)(c)(i) and (4)(d)(i) of section 6 of this act shall be the Chairman of the Truk State Congressional Delegation. The allottee of the all other funds appropriated under sub-patagraphs (1) $4\pi d$ (4) ϕf section 5 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated hudet enptagraph (2) of eection 2 of thie act enall be the uppet nottlocks development anthotity/ the allottee of the thinds apptopitated hudet enpthategianh (3) of eection b of this act shall be the hid-hottlocks development authority/ The allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (1) and subsections (4)(a)(ii), (4)(b)(ii), (4)(c)(ii), (4)(d)(ii), and (4)(e) of section 6 of this act shall be the Hall Islands Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraphs (2) and (5) of section 6 of this act shall be the Weito Islands Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraphs (3) and (6) of section 6 of this act shall be the Pattiw Islands Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under sub-paragraph (7) of section 6 of this act shall be the Board of Directors of the Nomwin Co-op. Each allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of

the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse until expended." Section 3.
