## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To make Mrs. Takea Kaewaniti Jacob eligible for naturalization as a citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Mrs. Takea Kaewaniti Jacob, a citizen of the
- 2 Republic of Kiribati now residing in the State of Pohnpei, by
- 3 virtue of compliance with the provisions of section 204 of
- 4 title 7 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, is
- 5 declared eligible for Federated States of Micronesia
- 6 citizenship, subject to approval by the President of the
- 7 Federated States of Micronesia in the exercise of the power
- 8 granted to him by said section 204 of title 7 of the Code of
- 9 the Federated States of Micronesia.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
- 11 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
- 12 becoming law without such approval.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To make Mrs. Takea Kaewaniti Jacob eligible for naturalization as a citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Mrs. Takea Kaewaniti Jacob, a citizen of the Republic of Kiribati now residing in the State of Pohnpei, by 2 virtue of compliance with the provisions of section 204 of 3 title 7 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, is 4 declared eligible for Federated States of Micronesia citizenship, subject to approval by the President of the 6 Federated States of Micronesia in the exercise of the power 7 granted to him by said section 204 of title 7 of the Code of 8 the Federated States of Micronesia. 9 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the 10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its 11 becoming law without such approval. 12
