A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 8-18 by amending sections 1, 3, 5, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 17 to appropriate the sum of \$3,044,814 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, as supplemental funding for the executive branch, judicial branch, agencies of the National Government, post-secondary educational assistance, other National Government programs, grants, subsidies, contributions and refunds and the National Development Budget; to specify the apportionment of funds for the College of Micronesia-FSM, post-secondary education assistance and Compact section 221(b) programs; to authorize one more position in the National Postal Service; to remove the lapse date on funds for the Continental Airlines Scholarship; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 8-18 is hereby amended

2 to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch. The
4 sum of ~~\$12,259,238~~ 12,264,481, or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
6 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
7 September 30, 1994, for the operations of the executive branch
8 of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia
9 during fiscal year 1994. Of the total funds appropriated under
10 this section \$546,389 shall be deemed to come from the funds
11 available under section 216(a)(1) of the Compact of Free
12 Association. The sum appropriated by this section shall be
13 apportioned as follows:

18 The funds appropriated under this section shall be deemed to
19 have come from the funds available under section 216(a)(3) of
20 the Compact of Free Association. The sum appropriated by this

2 This appropriation shall be released only when the following
3 conditions are met:

4 (i) Funds for Chuuk State scholarships will
5 be administered by the FSM Department of Education. Chuuk
6 State will submit its guidelines and proposed recipients'
7 names to the Secretary of the Department of Education, who will
8 award scholarships to eligible candidates based on Chuuk State's
9 guidelines, after investigating to make sure the candidates meet
10 the State's criteria. The Secretary of Education will make
11 every effort to make the scholarship awards before the beginning
12 of the school year or semester, and will send the awards directly
13 to the schools, rather than to the recipients themselves.

14 (ii) Yap State must award scholarships to
15 eligible students who plan to attend COM schools as well as to
16 those students going to other post-secondary institutions. Yap
17 State may not discriminate against COM students in giving
18 scholarship awards.

19 (iii) Kosrae State must set aside some of its
20 216(a)(3) funds for scholarships to be awarded only to students
21 attending or accepted at COM schools.

22 (iv) Pohnpei State must scrutinize its award
23 guidelines and procedures, and publish them as soon as possible."
