A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 5-59, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-116, 6-76 and 7-66, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-116 and 7-66, to modify the use of certain funds previously appropriated for Yap State public projects; by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-116 and 6-76, to establish a lapse date for the authority to obligate funds; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 5-59, as amended by
2	Public Laws Nos. 5-116 and 7-66, is hereby further amended to read as
3	follows:
4	"Section 2. The sum appropriated under section 1 of this
5	act shall be apportioned as follows:

10	Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 5-59, as amended by
11	Public Laws Nos. 5-116 and 6-76, is hereby further amended to read
12	as follows:
13	"Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
14	allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
15	accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
16	to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee
17	shall be the Governor of Yap State who shall be responsible
18	for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
19	necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
20	act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
21	sum appropriated. The allottee may reprogram up to 15
22	percent to and from the funds appropriated under each
23	subsection of section 2 of this act. The authority of the
24	allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall
25	popt lapse as of September 30, 1997."
