

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-19, as amended by Public Law No. 8-72, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Law No. 8-72, for the purpose of modifying the allocation of funds previously appropriated for Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
