"Section 921. Application of subchapter. This 4 subchapter shall apply to any agreement, regardless of 5 its form, which is intended to give rights in personal 6 property, including houses on land not owned 7 individually or entirely by the party or parties 8 9 purporting to give an interest in the house, as security 10 for the performance of any obligation. Such agreements 11 include, among others, pledges, conditional sales agreements, chattel mortgages, and leases under which 12 ownership of personal property is to pass upon 13 completion of the terms of the lease. Notwithstanding 14 15 the foregoing, this subchapter shall not apply to any 16 agreement creating rights in intangible personal 17 property as security for the performance of any obligation under any loan from the National Government 18 19 to a State of the Federated States of Micronesia."
