A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 9-096 by amending section 16 to change allottees and lapse provisions of funds appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 16 of Public Law No. 9-096 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and 3 . lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial 7 Management Act of 1979; PROVIDED, however, that the 8 funds appropriated to Chuuk State under subsection 9 . (3) of section 10 of this act shall be retained in 10 the General Fund of the Federated States of 11 Micronesia until a scholarship recipient is 12 identified to the President or the President's 13 designee, at which time scholarship funds in the 14 amount of the scholarship award shall be disbursed 15 directly to the educational institution in the form 16 of a two-party check payable to both the scholarship 17 recipient and the educational institution he or she 18 is attending; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the 19 allottees for the funds appropriated under 20 subsection (2)(o) and subsection (2)(ee) of section 21 11 of this act shall be the Governors of the 22 respective States, and no funds appropriated under 23 subsection (2)(o) of section 11 of this act shall be 24 disbursed from the General Fund to the allottees 25

unless the President certifies that the State involved has entered into a joint law enforcement agreement for the period of October 1, 1996, to September 30, 1997, with the National Government pursuant to chapter 12 of the title 12 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottees for the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(s) of section 11 of this act shall be the Chief Justices of the respective States; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottee of funds under section 7 of this act shall be Secretary of the Department of Transportation and Communication or his designee, but the Secretary shall designate an allottee of funds apportioned for radio telecommunications in a State only after consultation with the State's delegation to Congress. Each allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 199\$7; PROVIDED, however, that the authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by

sections 7, 9, 10, 11(2)(w), and 13 shall not lapse: and PROVIDED FURTHER. that the authority of the 2 allottee to obligate such portion of funds 3 appropriated by subsection (2)(h) of section 1 that is in excess of the amount necessary to make the yen purchase prescribed therein shall expire upon completion of said purchase. " Section 2.
