A RESOLUTION

Declaring the policy of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to disapprove of new foreign fishing agreements where the access fee for foreign fishing is less than fifteen percent (15%) of the value of the fish caught per annum in the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) of the Federated States of Micronesia.

WHEREAS, the Micronesian Maritime Authority (MMA) shall be guided 1 by the policy directives from the Congress of the Federated States of 2 3 Micronesia; and WHEREAS, foreign fishing in the EEZ of the Federated States of 4 Micronesia has generated substantial revenue for foreign ventures; and 5 WHEREAS, the benefits, including revenue, to the citizens of the 6 Federated States of Micronesia are inadequate to justify existing 7 foreign fishing agreements and new foreign fishing agreements under 8 existing terms; and 9 WHEREAS, the pelagic resources in the EEZ of the Federated States 10 of Micronesia are finite and shall be regulated in a sustainable and 11 financially responsible manner; and 12 WHEREAS, the exploitation of pelagic resources in the EEZ of the 13 Federated States of Micronesia is an important foundation for the economic 14 development of the Federated States of Micronesia; now, therefore, 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Ninth Congress of the Federated States of 16 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1995, that the Congress shall 17 disapprove of new foreign fishing agreements where the access fee for 18 foreign fishing is less than fifteen percent (15%) of the value of the 19 fish caught per annum in the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) of the 20 Federated States of Micronesia. 21
