

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145 and 9-013, and by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 8-149, 9-004 and 9-013, to change the use and the allottee of funds previously appropriated for the Faichuk District of Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public  
2 Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145 and 9-013, is hereby further amended to read

1           Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public  
2 Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 8-149, 9-004 and 9-013, is hereby further  
3 amended to read as follows:

4           "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
5 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
6 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to,  
7 the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the  
8 funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a) of section 2 of this  
9 act shall be the ~~PNE/Development/Authority~~ Director of the  
10 Office of Administrative Services, or his designee, except that  
11 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
12 (1)(a)(iv)c) of section 2 shall be the Tolesom Economic  
13 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
14 subsections (1)(b)(i), (1)(b)(ii), (1)(b)(iii) and (1)(b)(iv)  
15 of section 2 of this act shall be Mayor of Fono. The allottee  
16 of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(v),  
17 (1)(b)(vi) and (1)(b)(vii) of section 2 of this act shall be  
18 the Mayor of Pis-Paneu. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
19 under subsections (1)(b)(viii), (1)(b)(x), (1)(b)(xi) and  
20 (1)(b)(xvii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of  
21 Weno. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
22 (1)(b)(ix), (1)(b)(xii), (1)(b)(xiii), (1)(b)(xiv), (1)(b)(xv),  
23 (1)(b)(xvi) and (1)(b)(xviii) of section 2 of this act shall be  
24 the Weno Projects Coordinator. The allottee of the funds  
25 appropriated under subsection (1)(c) of section 2 of this act




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1 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The  
2 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of  
3 section 2 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks Development  
4 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
5 subsection (1)(e)(i) and (1)(e)(ii) of section 2 of this act  
6 shall be the Executive Director of the Hall Development  
7 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
8 subsection (1)(e)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
9 Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of the funds  
10 appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(iv), (1)(e)(v) and  
11 (1)(e)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall be the Weito  
12 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
13 under subsections (1)(e)(vii), (1)(e)(viii), (1)(e)(ix),  
14 (1)(e)(x), (1)(e)(xi)a), (1)(e)(xii), and (1)(e)(xiii) of  
15 section 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw Development  
16 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
17 subsections (1)(e)(xi)b) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
18 Director of Public Safety for the State of Chuuk. The allottee  
19 of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(e)(xi)c) of  
20 section 2 of this act shall be the Director of the Chuuk State  
21 Department of Agriculture. The allottee of the funds  
22 appropriated under subsections (1)(f)(i), (1)(f)(ii) and  
23 (1)(f)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall be the Executive  
24 Director of COCA. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
25 subsection (1)(f)(iii), (1)(f)(iv) and (1)(f)(v) of section 2

1 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk. The  
2 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(f)(vii)  
3 of section 2 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks  
4 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
5 under subsection (2)(a)(i) of section 2 of this act shall be  
6 the Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuafik. The allottee of the funds  
7 appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(ii) of section 2 of this  
8 act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Nukuoro. The allottee of  
9 the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(iii) of section  
10 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Kapingamarangi.  
11 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
12 (2)(a)(iv) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of  
13 Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
14 subsections (2)(a)(v)a), (2)(a)(v)b) and 2(a)(v)i) of section 2  
15 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs. The  
16 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(b),  
17 (2)(c), (2)(e), (2)(f), (4)(b), (4)(c), (4)(d), (4)(e), (4)(f),  
18 (4)(g), (4)(h), (4)(i), (4)(j) and (4)(k) of section 2 of this  
19 act shall be the President of the Federated States of  
20 Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
21 subsections (2)(a)(v)c) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
22 Pohnpei Utility Corporation. The allottee of funds  
23 appropriated under subsection (2)(d) of section 2 of this act  
24 shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The allottee of  
25 the funds appropriated under subsection 3 of section 2 of this

1 act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap or his designee.  
2 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(a)  
3 of section 2 of this act shall be the Chairman of the Kosrae  
4 Sports Council. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
5 subsections (4)(1) and (4)(n) of section 2 of this act shall be  
6 the Mayor of the Lelu Municipal Government. The allottee of  
7 the funds appropriated under subsections (4)(m) and (4)(o) of  
8 section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Malem Municipal  
9 Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
10 subsection (4)(p) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
11 President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee  
12 of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(q) of section 2  
13 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Tafunsak Municipal  
14 Government. The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring  
15 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are  
16 used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no  
17 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.  
18 The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated  
19 by this act shall not lapse."

20 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President  
21 of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such  
22 approval.
