A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 8-149, 9-004 and 9-013, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145 and 9-013, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein for Pohnpei State, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 8-149, 9-004 and 9-013, for the purpose of changing an allottee of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79,  
2 8-116, 8-145 and 9-013, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

12 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79,  
 13 8-116, 8-145, 8-149, 9-004 and 9-013, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

14 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered,  
 15 and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the  
 16 Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
 17 subsection (1)(a) of section 2 of this act shall be the PWP Development Authority,  
 18 except that the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a)(iv)c) of  
 19 section 2 shall be the Tolesom Economic Authority. The allottee of the funds  
 20 appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(i), (1)(b)(ii), (1)(b)(iii) and (1)(b)(iv)  
 21 of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Fono. The allottee of the funds  
 22 appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(v), (1)(b)(vi) and (1)(b)(vii) of section 2  
 23 of this act shall be the Mayor of Pis-Paneu. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
 24 under subsections (1)(b)(viii), (1)(b)(x), (1)(b)(xi), and (1)(b)(xvii) of  
 25 section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno. The allottee of funds appropriated



1 under subsections (1)(b)(ix), (1)(b)(xii), (1)(b)(xiii), (1)(b)(xiv),  
2 (1)(b)(xv), (1)(b)(xvi), and (1)(b)(xviii) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
3 Weno Projects Coordinator. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
4 (1)(c) of section 2 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority.  
5 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of section 2 of this act  
6 shall be the Lower Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the funds  
7 appropriated under subsection (1)(e)(i) and (1)(e)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall  
8 be the Executive Director of the Hall Development Authority. The allottee of the funds  
9 appropriated under subsection (1)(e)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw  
10 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections  
11 (1)(e)(iv), (1)(e)(v) and (1)(e)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall be the Weito  
12 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections  
13 (1)(e)(vii), (1)(e)(viii), (1)(e)(ix), (1)(e)(x), (1)(e)(xi)a), (1)(e)(xii),  
14 and (1)(e)(xiii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw Development Authority.  
15 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(xi)b) of section 2 of  
16 this act shall be the Director of Public Safety for the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the  
17 funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(xi)c) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
18 Director of the Chuuk State Department of Agriculture. The allottee of the funds  
19 appropriated under subsections (1)(f)(i), (1)(f)(ii) and (1)(f)(vi) of section 2 of  
20 this act shall be the Executive Director of COCA. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
21 under subsection (1)(f)(iii), (1)(f)(iv) and (1)(f)(v) of section 2 of this act shall  
22 be the Governor of the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
23 subsection (1)(f)(vii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks  
24 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
25 (2)(a)(i) of section 2 of this act shall be the Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuafik. The allottee

1 of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be  
2 the Chief Magistrate of Nukuoro. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
3 subsection (2)(a)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of  
4 Kapingamarangi. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(iv)  
5 of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds  
6 appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)a), (2)(a)(v)b) and 2(a)(v)i) of section  
7 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs. The allottee of the funds  
8 appropriated under subsections (2)(b), (2)(c)(i), (2)(c)(iii), (2)(e), (2)(f),  
9 (4)(b), (4)(c), (4)(d), (4)(e), (4)(f), (4)(g), (4)(h), (4)(i), (4)(j) and  
10 (4)(k) of section 2 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of  
11 Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)c) of  
12 section 2 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation. The allottee of funds  
13 appropriated under subsections (2)(c)(ii) and (2)(d) of section 2 of this act shall be  
14 the Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
15 subsection 3 of section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap or his  
16 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(a) of section 2  
17 of this act shall be the Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council. The allottee of the funds  
18 appropriated under subsections (4)(l) and (4)(n) of section 2 of this act shall be the  
19 Mayor of the Lelu Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
20 subsections (4)(m) and (4)(o) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the  
21 Malem Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
22 (4)(p) of section 2 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of  
23 Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(q) of section  
24 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Tafunsak Municipal Government. The allottees  
25 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be

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
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1 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations  
2 are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to  
3 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

4 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated  
5 States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
