

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$200,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, for the purpose of providing funds for the repair, replacement and upgrading of the FSM States' radio broadcasting equipment, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may be  
2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated  
3 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, for  
4 the purpose of providing funds for the repair, replacement and upgrading  
5 of the FSM States' radio broadcasting equipment, PROVIDED, that no part  
6 of such funds shall be used for purchase, rental, or other use of  
7 vehicles, or for fuel, training of personnel, or travel. The sum  
8 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:


9	(1) Chuuk .....	\$ 50,000
10	(2) Kosrae .....	50,000
11	(3) Pohnpei .....	50,000
12	(4) Yap .....	50,000

13           Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,  
14 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable  
15 law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.  
16 The allottee of the funds appropriated herein shall be the President of  
17 the Federated States of Micronesia or the President's designee. The  
18 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much  
19 thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in  
20 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
21 appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds  
22 appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1997.

1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law  
3 without such approval.
