A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 9-013 and 9-065, to reallocate funds previously appropriated therein, by further amending section 3, as amended, for the purpose of changing an allottee of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79,
2 8-116, 8-145, 9-013 and 9-065 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

17 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79,
 18 8-116, 8-145, 8-149, 9-004 and 9-013, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

19 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered,
 20 and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the
 21 Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
 22 subsection (1)(a) of section 2 of this act shall be the PWP Development Authority,
 23 except that the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a)(iv)c),
 24 (1)(a)(v) and (1)(a)(vi) of section 2 shall be the ~~Polle Municipal Authority~~
 25 Mayor of Polle Municipality. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections

1 (1)(b)(i), (1)(b)(ii), (1)(b)(iii) and (1)(b)(iv) of section 2 of this act shall be
2 the Mayor of Fono. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
3 (1)(b)(v), (1)(b)(vi) and (1)(b)(vii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of
4 Pis-Paneu. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(viii),
5 (1)(b)(x), (1)(b)(xi), and (1)(b)(xvii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor
6 of Weno. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(ix),
7 (1)(b)(xii), (1)(b)(xiii), (1)(b)(xiv), (1)(b)(xv), (1)(b)(xvi), and
8 (1)(b)(xviii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Weno Projects Coordinator. The
9 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(c) of section 2 of this act shall
10 be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
11 appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of section 2 of this act shall be the Lower
12 Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
13 subsection (1)(e)(i) and (1)(e)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Executive
14 Director of the Hall Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated
15 under subsection (1)(e)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw Development
16 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(iv),
17 (1)(e)(v) and (1)(e)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall be the Weito Development
18 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(vii),
19 (1)(e)(viii), (1)(e)(ix), (1)(e)(x), (1)(e)(xi)a, (1)(e)(xi)c (1)(e)(xii),
20 and (1)(e)(xiii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw Development Authority.
21 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(xi)b of section 2 of
22 this act shall be the Director of Public Safety for the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the
23 funds appropriated under subsections (1)(f)(i), (1)(f)(ii) and (1)(f)(vi) of
24 section 2 of this act shall be the Executive Director of COCA. The allottee of the funds
25 appropriated under subsection (1)(f)(iii), (1)(f)(iv) and (1)(f)(v) of section 2

1 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds
2 appropriated under subsection (1)(f)(vii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Lower
3 Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
4 subsection (2)(a)(i) of section 2 of this act shall be the Luhkenkolwof of Sapwuaifik.
5 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(ii) of section 2 of this
6 act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Nukuoro. The allottee of the funds appropriated
7 under subsection (2)(a)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of
8 Kapingamarangi. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(iv)
9 of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds
10 appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)a, (2)(a)(v)b and 2(a)(v)i) of section
11 2 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs. The allottee of the funds
12 appropriated under subsections (2)(b), (2)(c)(i), (2)(c)(iii), (2)(e), (2)(f),
13 (4)(b), (4)(c), (4)(d), (4)(e), (4)(f), (4)(g), (4)(h), (4)(i), (4)(j) and
14 (4)(k) of section 2 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of
15 Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)c) of
16 section 2 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation. The allottee of funds
17 appropriated under subsections (2)(c)(ii) and (2)(d) of section 2 of this act shall be
18 the Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
19 subsection 3 of section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap or his
20 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(a) of section 2
21 of this act shall be the Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council. The allottee of the funds
22 appropriated under subsections (4)(l) and (4)(n) of section 2 of this act shall be the
23 Mayor of the Lelu Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
24 subsections (4)(m) and (4)(o) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the
25 Malem Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection



1 (4)(p) of section 2 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of
 2 Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4)(q) of section
 3 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Tafunsak Municipal Government. The allottees
 4 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
 5 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligation
 6 are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to
 7 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

8 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated
 9 States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
