

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 20-107

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-54, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-62, 19-75, 19-79, 19-99, 19-119, 19-129, 19-136, 19-144, 19-173 and 20-04, by amending section 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 19-54, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 19-62, 19-79, 19-99, 19-119, 19-129, 19-136,  
3 19-144 and 19-173, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

5 this act, \$2,100,000 is apportioned for public projects
