AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 20-53, by amending the title, sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 thereof, to appropriate additional \$500,000, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs, and change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the states of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

23	amended to read as follows:
24	"Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
25	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be

allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
under sections 2 and 3 of this act shall be the President
of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsections 2(a) to 2(af) of this act shall be the Mayor
of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsection 2(ag) shall be the
Secretary of Education or his designee; the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsections 2(ah) to 2(am) of
this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal
Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a), 3(1)(b), 3(1)(c),
3(1)(e), 3(1)(g), 3(1)(j), 3(1)(p), 3(1)(r), 3(2)(b),
3(2)(c), $3(2)(d)$, $3(2)(e)$ and $3(2)(o)$ of this act shall be
the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsections $3(3)(f)$, $3(3)(1)$ and
3(3)(m) of this act shall be the Lukenmenlap of Kitti; the
allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(3)(q)

1 and 3(3)(r) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility 2 Corporation; the allottee of fund appropriated under 3 subsections 4(7)(a), 4(7)(b), 4(7)(c), 4(7)(d) and 4(7)(e) 4 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The 5 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 4(1), 6 4(3), 4(6) and 4(7) of this act shall be the Governor of 7 Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(2) of this act shall be 8 9 the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the 10 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(4) 11 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development 12 Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under 13 subsection 4(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk 14 Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to 15 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on 16 September 30, 2020." 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25
