AN ACT

To amend section 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, 20-01, 20-14 and 20-23, in order to change the use of funds for a particular line item, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

DE	II EMACIED DE THE CONCRETE OF
1	Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by
2	Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, 20-01,
3	20-14 and 20-23, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

5	The sum of \$40,606,363, which includes \$556,074 in SEG
6	funding that was previously omitted, or so much thereof
7	as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
8	General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
9	the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the
10	following capital improvements, development programs,
11	and projects and human resources development. Of the
12	total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$1,802,096
13	shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
14	Amended Compact from the Supplemental Education Grant
15	and \$9,545,500 shall be deemed to come from funds
16	available under the Amended Compact from Compact Sector
