CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 20-150, C.D.1

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113, 18-121, 19-05, 19-34, 19-57, 19-74, 19-107, 20-18 and 20-24, by amending sections 2 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Yap and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by

PUBLIC LAW No. 20- 80

Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113, 19-05, 19-34, 19-57, 19-74 and 20-18, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Of the \$2,800,000 appropriated in this act, \$1,200,000 is appropriated for public projects and social programs for the people of the state of Chuuk.
