

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$26,177,632 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, judicial branch, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds of the National Government during fiscal year 1998; to establish a budget for Compact sections 214(b), 215(a)(2), 216(a)(2), 216(a)(3), and 221(b) and to appropriate special funds available therefor under the Compact; to establish a development budget and to appropriate funds available therefor under the Compact; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch.

2 The sum of \$11,981,773, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
3 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated
4 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
5 1998, for the operations of the executive branch of the
6 National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia
7 during fiscal year 1998. Of the total funds appropriated under
8 this section, \$519,000 shall be deemed to come from the funds
9 available under section 216(a)(1) of the Compact of Free
10 Association. The sum appropriated by this section shall be
11 apportioned as follows:

13 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
14 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
15 year ending September 30, 1998, to pay utility bills for National
16 Government offices, operate and maintain standby generators, and
17 establish energy conservation programs, including the purchase
18 and installation of energy efficient air conditioners and other
19 appliances for National Government buildings. The funds

4 section 216(a)(3) of the Compact of Free Association.

5 Section 10. Post-secondary educational assistance. The sum
6 of \$1,089,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
7 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, for the
9 purpose of providing post-secondary educational assistance. The
10 funds appropriated under this section shall be deemed to come
11 from funds available under section 216(a)(3) of the Compact of
12 Free Association. The sum appropriated by this section shall be
13 apportioned as follows:

19 \$450,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
20 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of

13 individually to each of the departments and offices of the
14 executive and legislative branches, the National judiciary, the
15 Public Auditor, and to the agencies as provided in subsection (1)

22 Section 15. Reprogramming.

23 (1) The President may reprogram up to 10 percent to and

25 section 1. The President or his designee may reprogram up to 15

1 percent to and from the funds appropriated to any division, and
2 may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from each line within the
3 budget of a division, within a department or office or its
4 functional equivalent.

5 (2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10
6 percent to and from the funds appropriated to each of the
7 subsections in section 2, and may reprogram up to 15 percent to
8 and from the funds appropriated in each of the lines within the
9 subsections of section 2.

10 (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up
11 to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated in each of the
12 lines in section 3.

13 (4) The Public Auditor may reprogram up to 15 percent
14 to and from the funds appropriated in each of the lines in
15 section 4.

16 (5) Allottees of funds may reprogram up to 15 percent to
17 and from the funds appropriated in each of the lines within the
18 subsections of section 5.

19 (6) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (1)
20 through (5) of this section, no funds may be reprogrammed to any
21 personnel account (except as necessary in conjunction with a
22 position transfer permitted under section 14(2) of this act) or
23 subparagraph (a)(iii) of subsection (12) of section 1 of
24 this act.

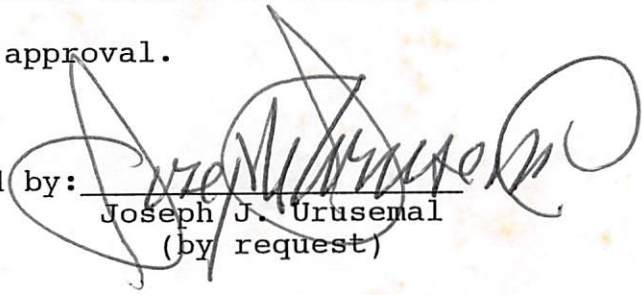
25 Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and lapse

1 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
2 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
3 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
4 Management Act of 1979, as amended; PROVIDED, however, that the
5 funds appropriated to Chuuk State under subsection (3) of section
6 10 of this act shall be retained in the General Fund of the
7 Federated States of Micronesia until a scholarship recipient is
8 identified to the President or the President's designee, at which
9 time scholarship funds in the amount of the scholarship award
10 shall be disbursed directly to the educational institution in the
11 form of a two-party check payable to both the scholarship
12 recipient and the educational institution he or she is attending;
13 and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottees for the funds
14 appropriated under subsection (2)(o) of section 11 of this act
15 shall be the Governors of the respective States, and no funds
16 appropriated under subsection (2)(o) of section 11 of this act
17 shall be disbursed from the General Fund to the allottees unless
18 the President certifies that the State involved has entered into
19 a joint law enforcement agreement for the period of October 1,
20 1997 to September 30, 1998, with the National Government pursuant
21 to chapter 12 of the title 12 of the Code of the Federated States
22 of Micronesia; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottees for the
23 funds appropriated under subsection (2)(s) of section 11 of this
24 act shall be the Chief Justices of the respective States. Each
25 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or

1 so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the
2 purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are
3 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the
4 allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse
5 as of September 30, 1998; PROVIDED, however, that the authority
6 of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by sections 7, 9,
7 10, 11(2)(w), and 13 shall not lapse.

8 Section 17. Effective date. This act shall become law upon
9 approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
10 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
