A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$26,177,632 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, judicial branch, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds of the National Government during fiscal year 1998; to establish a budget for Compact sections 214(b), 215(a)(2), 216(a)(2), 216(a)(3), and 221(b) and to appropriate special funds available therefor under the Compact; to establish a development budget and to appropriate funds available therefor under the Compact; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Operating expenses of the executive branch. Section 1. The sum of \$11,981,773, or so much thereof as may be necessary, 2 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated 3 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, for the operations of the executive branch of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1998.
