A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-030, as amended, by further amending section 11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-039, 9-048, and 9-091, to further specify the use of funds appropriated therein for sports facilities in the State of Chuuk, and by further amending section 16, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-046, 9-091 and 9-118, to extend the lapse date therefor, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 11 of Public Law No. 9-30, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-039, 9-048, and 9-091, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 11. Other National Government programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds. The sum of \$3,601,931, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, for special programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1996. The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

Section 2. Section 16 of Public Law No. 9-030, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-046, 9-091 and 9-118, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date. All

1 funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered,
2 and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not
3 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979; PROVIDED, however,
4 that the allottees for the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(l)(i),
5 (2)(l)(ii) and (2)(l)(iv) of section 11 of this act shall be the Governors of
6 the respective States and the allottee for the funds appropriated under
7 subsection (2)(l)(iii) of section 11 of this act shall be the Director of
8 Public Safety for the State of Chuuk and that all funds appropriated
9 under subsection (2)(l) of section 11 of this act shall not be disbursed
10 from the General Fund to the allottees unless the President certifies that
11 the State involved has entered into a joint law enforcement agreement
12 for the period of October 1, 1995, to September 30, 1996, with the
13 National Government pursuant to chapter 12 of title 12 of the Code of
14 the Federated States of Micronesia; PROVIDED FURTHER, that all funds
15 appropriated to Chuuk State under subsection (3) of section 10 of this
16 act shall be retained in the General Fund of the Federated States of
17 Micronesia until a scholarship recipient is identified to the President or the
18 President's designee, at which time scholarship funds in the amount of the
19 scholarship award shall be disbursed directly to the appropriate
20 educational institution in the form of a two-party check payable to both
21 the scholarship recipient and the educational institution he or she is
22 attending; PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottees for the funds
23 appropriated under subsection (2)(o) of section (11) of this act shall be
24 the Chief Justices of the respective States; PROVIDED FURTHER, that the
25 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(k)(i) shall be the

1 Mayor of Udot Municipality; PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottee of the
2 funds appropriated under subsection (1)(k)(ii) of section 12 of this act
3 shall be the Governor of the State of Yap; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that
4 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1) of section 13
5 of this act shall be the Director of the Office of Administrative Services.
6 Each allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so
7 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose
8 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
9 sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds
10 appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1996;
11 PROVIDED, however, that the authority of the allottees to obligate funds
12 appropriated by sections 7, 9, 10, 11(2)(s), and 13 shall not lapse, the
13 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by subsection
14 (1)(e) of section 2 of this act shall lapse as of December 31, 1996, and
15 the authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by
16 ~~subsection (2)(aa) of section 11~~ subsection (1)(a)(v) of section 1
17 and subsection (1)(k) of section 12 of this act shall lapse as of
18 September 30, 1998. It shall be further provided that the authority of
19 the allottee of the funds appropriated by ~~subsection (1)(a)(v) of~~
20 ~~section 11~~ subsection (2)(aa) of section 11 of this act shall lapse as of
21 September 30, 1998."

22 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the
23 Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
