A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$149,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, for the purpose of completing the COM-FSM State Campuses in Yap and Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. The sum of \$51,000, or so much thereof as may
- 2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
- 3 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
- 4 September 30, 1998, for the purpose of completing the ongoing
- 5 construction of the COM-FSM State Campus in Kosrae.
- 6 Section 2. The sum of \$98,000, or so much thereof as may
- 7 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
- 8 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
- 9 September 30, 1998, for the purpose of completing the ongoing
- 10 construction of the COM-FSM State Campus in Yap.
- 11 Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
- 12 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
- 13 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
- 14 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of
- 15 the funds appropriated by this act shall be the President of
- 16 the Federated States of Micronesia or the President's
- 17 designee. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring
- 18 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are
- 19 used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
- 20 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
- 21 appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate
- 22 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September
- 23 30, 1999.
