A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by further amending section 164 thereof, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-62 and 10-96, and by further amending section 509, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-62 and 10-118, for the purpose of replacing compensatory time with straight time as compensation for excess hours, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 164 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws 2 Nos. 9-155, 10-62 and 10-96, is hereby further amended to 3 read as follows: 4 "Section 164. Differentials. 5 To compensate for unusual circumstances of 6 employment which create hardships for public 7 service employees, the following differentials are 8 provided for them; provided that in no case may an 9 employee receive differentials under both 10 subsections (1) and (2) of this section: 11 Night work differential. An (1)12 employee whose tour of duty includes regularly 13 scheduled hours falling between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. 14 shall be paid a differential of fifteen percent of 15 the adjusted base salary for all hours falling 16 within that period. 17 Hazardous work differential. An 18 employee whose position entails unusual and 19 extreme hazards to his health or safety shall be 20 paid a differential of twenty-five percent of the 21 adjusted base salary for all hours in which 22 hazardous work is performed. 23 [(3) Overtime differential. If an 24

employee is eligible to receive overtime

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1	compensation under section 509 of title 52, he
2	shall be paid overtime compensation at the rate of
3	time and one half of his adjusted base salary for
4	all time when he is directed to work and does work
5	in excess of eight hours in one day; or when he is
6	directed to work and does work on the sixth or
7	seventh day of the work week; provided that he has
8	first worked forty hours at straight time in the
9	same work week; and provided further, that
10	overtime work performed on a holiday shall be
11	subject to subsection (4) of this section.]
12	$[\frac{(4)}{(3)}]$ Holiday differential. An
13	employee who is required to work on a legal
14	holiday shall be compensated at double his
15	adjusted base salary for all such hours worked.
16	$[\frac{(5)}{(4)}]$ Typhoon emergency
17	differential. Employees who are required to work
18	in a location and a period in which a typhoon or
19	other natural catastrophe has been declared by
20	competent authority, and in which other Government
21	employees are released from work because of such
22	conditions, shall be compensated for the hours
23	worked while such emergency remains in force at
24	the rate of two and one-half times the adjusted
25	base salary. The differential provided in this

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subsection shall not limit the employee's right to any other differential or allowance to which he may otherwise be entitled by law or regulations.

[(6)] (5) Sea duty differential. An

employee of the Maritime Wing of the National Police shall be paid his adjusted base salary plus a differential of ten percent of his adjusted base salary for all hours actually worked, up to but not in excess of eight hours per day, in any day or fraction thereof, including the sixth and seventh day of the work week, that he is on duty at sea. No compensation, regular or overtime, no differential of any sort, and no compensatory time shall be due for any additional hours worked in any such day, regardless of how many hours the employee was actually required to work in that day. Hours actually worked while at sea, up to but not in excess of eight hours per day, shall count as straight time hours for the purpose of determining compensatory time, if any, in a work week spent partially at sea and partially not at sea. The holiday differential shall apply in lieu of the sea duty differential while at sea on a holiday. The hazardous work differential shall apply in addition to the sea duty differential

1	while at sea, provided that being at sea does not
2	in and of itself constitute hazardous work. The
3	typhoon emergency differential shall not apply
4	while at sea."
5	Section 2. Section 509 of title 52, as amended by
6	Public Laws Nos. 10-62 and 10-118, is hereby further amended
7	to read as follows:
8	"Section 509. Freeze on salary increases;
9	[compensatory time and] overtime compensation.
10	Notwithstanding any other applicable law, there is
11	hereby enacted:
12	(1) A freeze on annual salary step increases
13	of all employees in the public service system; and
14	(2) <u>Compensation at straight time for hours</u>
15	worked in excess of eight hours a day or forty
16	hours a week, except as provided by section 167 of
17	this title or subsection (3) herein.
18	[Compensatory time, with which employees in the
19	public service shall be credited in lieu of
20	receiving overtime compensation as otherwise
21	authorized under the National Public Service Act
22	and regulations promulgated thereunder.
23	Compensatory time means those hours authorized in
24	advance and worked by an employee outside
25	established work hours and for which the employee

1 is credited with one hour in the form of leave 2 with pay for each hour of work an employee is directed to and performs work in excess of the 3 regular 40 hour workweek as provided by law. 4 Compensatory time shall be accrued by National 5 6 Government public service employees and shall be 7 included in the compensation received by a program 8 participant pursuant to subsection (4)(c) of section 506 of this chapter; except that any 9 accumulation of time in excess of 280 hours shall 10 be forfeited unless taken before the end of the 11 calendar year in which the excess was accumulated. 12 13 For purposes of computing whether a program 14 employee's accrued compensatory and/or annual leave hours are in excess of 280 hours, accrued 15 compensatory time and annual leave shall be 16 17 included in computing the 280 hour ceiling.] (3) [Notwithstanding the provisions of this 18 19 section, a]An employee shall be entitled to receive overtime differential at the rate of time 20 and one-half of his adjusted base salary, pursuant 21 2.2 to regulation for hours authorized to work and actually worked in excess of eight in one day or 23 forty in one week, retroactive to the effective 24

date of Public Law No. 9-155 [with respect to

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1	paragraphs (a), (b) and (c), as authorized under
2	the National Public Service System Act], for:
3	(a) time worked in the event that the
4	National government would be entitled to
5	compensation for payment of such differential
6	under section 115 of title 50; or
7	(b) time worked in the event that
8	the National government would be entitled to
9	compensation for payment of such differential
10	through a written agreement with a legal
11	entity that seeks to provide relief from
12	emergency conditions, as long as the time
13	worked is directly related to efforts to
14	provide emergency relief, in accordance with
15	an emergency declared by the President under
16	article X, section 9 of the Constitution of
17	the Federated States of Micronesia.
18	(c) time worked in the event that
19	the National government would be entitled to
20	compensation for payment of such differential
21	through a written agreement with the Water
22	Users Corporation, as long as the time worked
23	is directly related to management and
24	maintenance of the Capital Water System.
25	(-(d) time worked as follows:

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1	(i) by personnel within the Division of
2	Budget in preparation of the annual budget
3	submission in the thirty day period prior to April
4	1;
5	(ii) by accounting personnel within the
6	Division of Treasury in preparing the annual
7	financial statements for the FSM National
8	Government, during the period from November 1
9	to December 31 of each year;
10	(iii) by accounting personnel within the
11	Division of Treasury in preparing reports pursuant
12	to section 226 of title 55 of the Code of the
13	Federated States of Micronesia, or a successor
14	provision, during the fifteen day periods leading
15	up to May 1 and November 1 of each year.
16	Notwithstanding section 164 of this title, persons
17	working hours entitling them to overtime
18	differential pursuant to paragraph (d) of
19	subsection (3) of this section shall receive
20	compensation at straight time for those hours.
21	Provided, however, that an employee performing
22	such overtime work on a holiday shall be entitled
23	to holiday differential in lieu of overtime
24	differential."
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1	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by
2	the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon
3	its becoming law without such approval.
