A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-052, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Law No. 9-071, to modify the use of certain funds appropriated therein for Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-052, as amended by Public Law No. 9-071, is
2 hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
4 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
5 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, for the purpose of
6 funding infrastructure needs, transportation systems, and other economic and
7 social projects, public projects and for other purposes in Chuuk State and for
8 Chuukese outside of Chuuk State. The funds appropriated under this section
9 shall be apportioned as follows:


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1 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the
