A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-93, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-98, 8-123, 8-137, 9-020 and 9-098, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-98 and 9-098, to modify the use of funds appropriated therein under subsection (2) and to exempt said funds from the lapse provisions of Public Law No. 9-040, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 8-93, as amended by Public Laws  
2 Nos. 8-98 and 9-098, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$1,300,000, or so much thereof as may be  
4 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the  
5 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
6 September 30, 1995, for school needs throughout the Federated  
7 States of Micronesia. The funds appropriated under this act  
8 shall be apportioned as follows:

- 9 (1) Chuuk
- 10 (a) Faichuk
- 11 (i) Public elementary school needs.....\$ 80,000
- 12 (ii) PIBC needs..... 5,000
- 13 (iii) Travel ..... 5,000
- 14 (iv) School site leases:
- 15 a) East Wolip Elementary School..... 5,000
- 16 b) Malaio Elementary School..... 5,000
- 17 (b) Northern Namoneas
- 18 (i) Elementary school needs..... 70,000
- 19 (ii) Junior high school needs..... 10,000
- 20 (iii) Other school needs..... 20,000
- 21 (c) Southern Namoneas..... 100,000
- 22 (d) Northwest Islands
- 23 (i) Namonweito..... 75,500
- 24 (ii) Other school needs..... 24,500
- 25 (e) Mortlocks..... 100,000

3 Section 2. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds whose  
 4 use is modified by this act shall be exempt from the lapse provisions of  
 5 Public Law No. 9-040.

6 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
 7 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming  
 8 law without such approval.
