A BILL FOR AN ACT


To make Leah P. Jano eligible for naturalization as a citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Leah P. Jano, a citizen of the Republic of
2 the Philippines, now residing in Pohnpei State, by virtue of
3 her compliance with the provisions of section 204 of title 7
4 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, is
5 declared eligible for Federated States of Micronesia
6 citizenship, subject to approval by the President of the
7 Federated States of Micronesia in the exercise of the power
8 granted to him by said section 204 of title 7 of the Code of
9 the Federated States of Micronesia.

10 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by
11 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon
12 its becoming law without such approval.


1 Section 1. Leah P. Jano, a citizen of the Republic of
