A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$85,000 in supplemental capital improvement project funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the renovation of the Courthouse in Yap, for the completion of small projects for the FSM Supreme Court in Chuuk, for the provision of standby power to the FSM Supreme Court Associate Justice's residence in Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
3 the Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of renovating
4 the Courthouse used by the FSM Supreme Court in Yap.

5 Section 2. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
7 the Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of completing
8 renovations to the FSM Supreme Courthouse in Chuuk.

9 Section 3. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
11 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of
12 providing standby power to the FSM Supreme Court Associate
13 Justice's residence in Chuuk.

14 Section 4. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
15 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance
16 with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
17 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be the Chief Justice
18 of the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
19 designee(s). The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that
20 the funds allotted are used solely for the purposes specified in
21 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
22 sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate
23 funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse.
