

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 9-013, 9-065 and 9-119, to reallocate funds previously appropriated therein, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79, 8-116, 8-145, 8-149, 9-004, 9-013, 9-055, 9-065, 9-119 and 10-48, for the purpose of changing an allottee of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79,
2 8-116, 8-145, 9-013, 9-065 and 9-119, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

14 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-79,
 15 8-116, 8-145, 8-149, 9-004, 9-013, 9-055, 9-065, 9-119 and 10-48, is hereby
 16 further amended to read as follows:

17 "Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
 18 administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including,
 19 but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the
 20 funds appropriated under subsection (1)(a) of section 2 of this act shall be the
 21 PWP Development Authority, except that the allottee of the funds appropriated
 22 under subsection (1)(a)(iv)c, (1)(a)(v) and (1)(a)(vi) of section 2 shall
 23 be the Mayor of Polle Municipality. The allottee of the funds appropriated
 24 under subsections (1)(b)(i), (1)(b)(ii), (1)(b)(iii) and (1)(b)(iv) of
 25 section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Fono. The allottee of the funds

1 appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(v), (1)(b)(vi) and (1)(b)(vii) of
2 section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Pis-Paneu. The allottee of the funds
3 appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(viii), (1)(b)(x), (1)(b)(xi), and
4 (1)(b)(xvii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno. The allottee
5 of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(ix), (1)(b)(xii),
6 (1)(b)(xiii), (1)(b)(xiv), (1)(b)(xv), (1)(b)(xvi), and (1)(b)(xviii)
7 of section 2 of this act shall be the Weno Projects Coordinator. The allottee of
8 the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(c) of section 2 of this act shall be
9 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
10 appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of section 2 of this act shall be the
11 Lower Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated
12 under subsection (1)(e) (i) and (1)(e)(ii) of section 2 of this act shall be the
13 Executive Director of the Hall Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
14 appropriated under subsection (1)(e)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the
15 Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
16 subsections (1)(e)(iv), (1)(e)(v) and (1)(e)(vi) of section 2 of this act
17 shall be the Weito Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
18 . appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(vii), (1)(e)(viii), (1)(e)(ix),
19 (1)(e)(x), (1)(e)(xi)a), (1)(e)(xi)c) (1)(e)(xii), and (1)(e)(xiii) of
20 section 2 of this act shall be the Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of
21 the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(e)(xi)b) of section 2 of this act
22 shall be the Director of Public Safety for the State of Chuuk. The allottee of
23 funds appropriated under subsection (1)(e)(xiv) of section 2 of this act shall
24 be the Namonweitto Project Coordinator.

1 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(f)(i), (1)(f)(ii)
2 and (1)(f)(vi) of section 2 of this act shall be the Executive Director of COCA.
3 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(f)(iii),
4 (1)(f)(iv) and (1)(f)(v) of section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the
5 State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
6 (1)(f)(vii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Lower Mortlocks Development
7 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(i)
8 of section 2 of this act shall be the Luhkenkolwof of Sapwufik. The allottee of
9 the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a)(ii) of section 2 of this act
10 shall be the Chief Magistrate of Nukuoro. The allottee of the funds appropriated
11 under subsection (2)(a)(iii) of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief
12 Magistrate of Kapingamarangi. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
13 subsection (2)(a)(iv) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of Kolonia
14 Town. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)a,
15 (2)(a)(v)b and 2(a)(v)i of section 2 of this act shall be the Chief
16 Magistrate of Sokehs. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
17 (2)(c)(i), (2)(c)(iii), (2)(e), (2)(f), (4)(b), (4)(c), (4)(d), (4)(e),
18 (4)(f), (4)(g), (4)(h), (4)(i), (4)(j) and (4)(k) of section 2 of this act
19 shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of the
20 funds appropriated under subsections (2)(a)(v)c) of section 2 of this act shall
21 be the Pohnpei Utilities Corporation. The allottee of the funds appropriated
22 under subsection (2)(b) of section 2 of this act shall be the Vice President of
23 the Federated States of Micronesia or the Vice President's designee. The allottee
24 of the funds appropriated under subsections (2)(c)(ii) and (2)(d) of section
25 2 funds appropriated under subsection 3 of section 2 of this act shall be the

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1 Governor of the State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds
 2 appropriated under subsection (4)(a) of section 2 of this act shall be the
 3 Chairman of the Kosrae Sports Council. The allottee of the funds appropriated
 4 under subsections (4)(l) and (4)(n) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor
 5 of the Lelu Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
 6 subsections (4)(m) and (4)(o) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of
 7 the Malem Municipal Government. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
 8 subsection (4)(p) of section 2 of this act shall be the President of the
 9 Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
 10 subsection (4)(q) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of the Tafunsak
 11 Municipal Government. The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that
 12 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the
 13 purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of
 14 the sum appropriated. Notwithstanding Public Law No. 9-040, the authority of
 15 the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

16 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated
 17 States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
