A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-100, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-104, 9-129, 9-150 and 10-1, to modify the purpose for which certain funds were appropriated for the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-
2 104, 9-129, 9-150 and 10-1, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,350,000, or so much thereof as may be
4 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
5 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September
6 30, 1997, for the purpose of funding the infrastructure, social and
7 economic development and other needs of the State of Chuuk. The
8 funds appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:
