A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 6-3, by amending section 2, to expand the categories of scholarship for which the Continental Airlines Scholarship funds may be used, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 6-3 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:


3 "Section 2. Continental Airlines Scholarship;
4 Requirements and uses.

5 The scholarship funds appropriated by this act and
6 all future appropriations for the Continental
7 Airlines scholarship program shall be administered
8 by the Department of ~~Human Resources~~ Health,
9 Education, and Social Affairs. These scholarship
10 funds shall be used for a scholarship program only
11 for graduate or undergraduate students in the
12 field of aviation; graduate or undergraduate
13 students in the field of civil engineering;
14 graduate and undergraduate students in the fields
15 of agriculture and marine resources; and graduate
16 students in the fields of law and medicine.

17 Scholarships under this program to undergraduate
18 students shall only be awarded to otherwise
19 eligible undergraduate students who have completed
20 2 years full-time study or its equivalent. The
21 Secretary of the Department of Human Resources, or
22 his designee, shall promulgate guidelines or
23 rules, governing the process of applying for
24 scholarships under this program, governing the
25 criteria for awarding scholarships under this

1 program, governing the process of selecting
 2 recipients of scholarships under this program,
 3 governing the terms and conditions, and the
 4 enforcement of such, for scholarships under this
 5 program, and such other matters as may be
 6 necessary and consistent with the provisions of
 7 this act. The promulgation of such guidelines or
 8 rules shall not be subject to the provisions of
 9 chapter 1 of title 17 of the Code of the Federated
 10 States of Micronesia regarding Administrative
 11 Procedures."

12 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by
 13 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon
 14 its becoming law without such approval.
