A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by further amending section 114, as amended by Public Law No. 5-105 and as renumbered by Public Law No. 10-14, for the purpose of allowing the issuance of citations and the collection of fees for the violation of certain provisions of chapter 1 or any regulations issued pursuant thereto without a hearing, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 114 of title 50 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 5-105
- 3 and as renumbered by Public Law No. 10-14, is hereby further amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 "Section 114. Penalties.
- (1) Any person who, not being a citizen of the 6 Federated States of Micronesia, unlawfully enters or 7 attempts to enter the Federated States of Micronesia or 8 having lawfully entered, remains willfully and unlawfully 9 after expiration or revocation of his entry 10 authorization, or who violates by act or omission any 11 provision of this chapter or regulations issued pursuant 12 thereto, upon conviction thereof shall be imprisoned for 13 a period of not more than two years, or fined not more 14 than \$10,000, or both. 15
 - (2) In lieu of subsection (1) of this section or in addition thereto, any person who unlawfully enters the Federated States of Micronesia or having lawfully entered, willfully and unlawfully remains after expiration or revocation of his entry permit shall be subject to deportation after hearing upon application by the President or his designee to any competent court in the Federated States of Micronesia.
 - (3) Any carrier violating the provisions of section 109 shall be fined \$500 per person for persons not allowed to

disembark or returned to an aircraft. 1 (4) Any person who fails to comply with subsection (5) 2 of section 103 of this chapter shall lack standing to 3 bring an action in the Supreme Court of the Federated 4 States of Micronesia for accounts due on sales made or 5 contracts entered into during the period of 6 noncompliance. (5) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2) of this 8 section, the President or his designee may issue a 9 citation and collect a fee in such amount provided by 10 regulations against any peson who violates any provision 11 of this chapter or regulations issued thereunder. The 12 provisions of subsections (1) and (2) of this section 13 shall apply if the defendant chooses to challenge the 14 citation issued or the fee charged." 15 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the 16 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming 17 law without such approval. 18 19 Introduced by: 20 21 22 23 24
