A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 10-119, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-132, 10-139 and 11-6, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Law No. 10-124, and by amending section 13; to appropriate the sum of \$380,868 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia to provide for supplemental appropriations of funds for various departments and offices for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, and for other purposes.
