

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by Public Law No. 11-39, by amending section 3 to apportion the Yap State funds, by further amending sections 4 and 5 as amended by Public Law No. 11-39, to modify the use of Kosrae State funds, to change the allottee of certain funds for the States of Kosrae and Yap and to provide that the funds appropriated under this act shall not lapse, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 11-27 is hereby amended to
2 read as follows:

3 "Section 3. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
5 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
6 September 30, 2000, for the purpose of funding infrastructure
7 projects, roads, and other economic and social projects and
8 programs in the State of Yap. The funds appropriated under
9 this section shall be apportioned as follows:

4 Section 2. Section 4 of Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by
5 Public Law No. 11-39, is hereby further amended to read as
6 follows:

7 "Section 4. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
9 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
10 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, for the
11 purpose of funding infrastructure projects, roads, and
12 other economic and social projects and programs in the
13 State of Kosrae. The funds appropriated under this
14 section shall be apportioned as follows:

15 (1) Kosrae State primary road paving
16 projects.....\$500,000

17 (2) Municipal projects, PROVIDED that no
18 more than 10% of the project appropriation may
19 be used for project administration and
20 implementation costs

16 Section 3. Section 5 of Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by
17 Public Law No. 11-39, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

18 "Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
19 date.

20 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be

1 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
2 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
3 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of
4 the funds appropriated by section 1 of this act shall be the
5 Executive Director of Chuuk State Commission on Improvement
6 Projects, or his designee. The allottee of the funds
7 appropriated by subsections 1 and subsections 3 through 10 of
8 section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of
9 Yap. The allottee of the funds appropriated by subsections 2
10 and 11 of section 3 of this act shall be the Secretary of the
11 Department of Transportation, Communication, and
12 Infrastructure. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
13 subsection 12 of section 3 of this act shall be the Speaker
14 of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia. The
15 allottee of the funds appropriated by subsection 1 and
16 subsection 3(a), 3(b) and 3(d) of section 4 of this act shall
17 be the Governor of Kosrae State. The allottee of the funds
18 appropriated by subsection 3(c) of section 4 of this act
19 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance and
20 Administration, or his designee. The allottee of the funds
21 appropriated by subsection 2 of section 4 of this act shall
22 be the mayors of the respective municipalities, PROVIDED
23 that, the mayors shall consult with the Kosrae Congressional
24 Delegation Members before obligating funds. The allottee of
25 all other funds appropriated by this act shall be the
26 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or the
27 President's designee. The allottees shall not obligate funds
28 appropriated under this act without consultation and

1 agreement on the most appropriate usage of said funds between
2 allottee and the relevant Congressional Delegation. The
3 allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds,
4 or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
5 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations
6 are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.

7 (2) The authority of the allottees to obligate funds
8 appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

9 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
11 law without such approval.
