A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 11-59, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-69 and 11-79, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-69 and 11-79, to change the use of certain funds appropriated for Election District No. 1 in Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 11-59, as amended by
 Public Laws Nos. 11-69 and 11-79, is hereby further amended to read as
 follows:

"Section 3. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof as may
be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
September 30, 2001, to provide funds for infrastructure and
other projects and programs in the State of Chuuk. The funds
