## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-052, as amended, by amending section 1 to change the use of Chuuk Election District No. 1 funds, and for other purposes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-052, as amended by 1 Section 1. Public Laws Nos. 10-46, 10-69, 10-106, 11-29 and 11-61, is hereby 2 further amended to read as follows: 3 4 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as may 5 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending 6 7 September 30, 1996, for the purpose of funding infrastructure needs, transportation systems, and other economic and social 8 9 projects, public projects and for other purposes in Chuuk 10 State and for Chuukese outside of Chuuk State.
