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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 11-27 by amending section 3 to change the use of certain funds appropriated for use within Yap State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by
2	Public Laws Nos. 11-55, 11-65, 11-78 and 12-3, is hereby further
3	amended to read as follows:
4	"Section 3. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as may
5	be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
6	the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
7	September 30, 2000, for the purpose of funding infrastructure
8	projects, roads, and other economic and social projects and
9	programs in the State of Yap. The funds appropriated under
10	this section shall be apportioned as follows:
11	(1) Dugor/Bael road\$ 100,000
12	(2) Gargey land development0-
13	(3) Weloy municipal office construction 100,000
14	(4) Deechmur, Tomil men's house project 50,000
15	(5) Outer island agriculture
16	development/cultural programs[143,000] 153,000
17	(6) Yap's social development seminars 25,000
18	(7) Wulu Village, Fanif power
19	and road extension

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1	(8) Atliw women's community project\$	20,000
2	(9) Rumuu lothog men's house project	50,000
3	(10) V6AI equipment purchase	80,000
4	(11) Outer island infrastructure	
5	development projects including projects	
6	for outer island communities on Yap	
7	proper (matching funds) PROVIDED THAT	
8	the Department of Finance and	
9	Administration shall allot only	
10	\$50,000 of these funds until such time	
11	as the full amount is available

8	(18) Travel and meeting expenses for Delegation		
9	to visit the Outer Islands of Yap 15,000"		
10	Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by		
11	Public Laws Nos. 11-39, 11-59, 11-65 and 11-78, is hereby further		
12	amended to read as follows:		
13	" <u>Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse</u>		
14	<u>date.</u>		
15	(1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be		
16	allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in		
17	accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited		
18	to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of		
19	the funds appropriated by section 1 of this act shall be the		
20	Executive Director of Chuuk State Commission on Improvement		
21	Projects, or his designee. The allottee of the funds		
22	appropriated by subsection (1), subsections (3) through		
23	(10), subsection (13) and subsections (15) through (17) of		
24	section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of		
25	Yap. The allottee of the funds appropriated by subsections		
26	(2) and (11) of section 3 of this act shall be the Secretary		

1	of the Department of Transportation, Communication and
2	Infrastructure. The allottee of the funds appropriated
3	under subsections (12) and (18) of section 3 of this act
4	shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States
5	of Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated by
6	subsection (1) and subsection (3)(a), (3)(b) and (3)(d) of
7	section 4 of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State.
8	The allottee of the funds appropriated by subsection (3)(c)
9	of section 4 of this act shall be the Secretaruy of the
10	Department of Finance and Administration, or his designee.
11	The allottee of the funds appropriated by subsection (2) of
12	section 4 of this act shall be the mayors of the respective
13	municipalities. The allottee of all other funds
14	appropriated by this act shall be the President of the
15	Federated States of Micronesia or the President's designee.
16	The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these
17	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
18	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
19	obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.
20	(2) The authority of the allottees to obligate funds
21	appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

Section  $[\frac{2}{3}]$ . This act shall become law upon approval by the 23 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming 24 law without such approval.
