## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To propose an amendment to section 2 of article IV of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia to provide for public assistance for the construction and maintenance of church facilities, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:


Section 1. Proposed amendment. It is hereby proposed that section 2 of article IV of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia be amended to read as follows:
"Section 2. No law may be passed respecting an establishment
of religion or impairing the free exercise of religion, except that public assistance may be provided to parochial schools for non-religious purposes, and for the construction and maintenance of church facilities in the Federated States of Micronesia."

Section 2. Procedure. This act shall become effective upon its passage by Congress as an act of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia. It shall be transmitted to the President for action in accordance with chapter 7 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, and shall become part of the Constitution following completion of the procedures, including its ratification by the people, as required by the Constitution and law.

Section 3. Effective date. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
