A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 12-50, as amended and restated, by amending section 3 thereof to appropriate an additional \$192,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2003 to provide supplemental funding for the operations of the Legislative Branch, by amending section 13 thereof to correct engrossing errors, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
