A RESOLUTION

Ratifying the Convention on the Conservation and Management of Highly Migratory Fish Stocks in the Western and Central Pacific Ocean.

1 WHEREAS, the Convention on the Conservation and Management of 2 Highly Migratory Fish Stocks in the Western and Central Pacific 3 Ocean ("the Convention") was adopted on September 4, 2000, at the 4 seventh session of the Multilateral High-Level Conference on the 5 Conservation and Management of Highly Migratory Fish Stocks in the 6 Western and Central Pacific Ocean; and

7 WHEREAS, under the 1982 United Nations Convention on the Law 8 of the Sea, coastal States and States fishing in the region shall 9 cooperate with a view to ensuring conservation and promoting the 10 objective of optimum utilization of highly migratory fish stocks 11 throughout their range; and

12 WHEREAS, the Convention is of great importance for ensuring 13 the long-term conservation and sustainable use, in particular for 14 human food consumption, of highly migratory fish stocks in the 15 Western and Central Pacific Ocean for present and future 16 generations in accordance with the 1982 United Nations Convention 17 on the Law of the Sea; and

18 WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 34 of the Convention, the 19 Convention was open for signature by certain States until 20 September 5, 2001, subject to ratification by the signatories; and 21 WHEREAS, the Convention was signed by the Secretary of the 22 Department of Foreign Affairs on behalf of the President of the
