

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-75, as amended, by further amending section 2 to change the use of certain Yap State funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-75, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 10-77, 10-111, 10-133 and 11-31, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:
