

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 11-59, as amended, by amending section 1 to change the use of certain funds for Kosrae State, by amending section 3 to change the use of certain funds for Chuuk State, by amending section 7 to change the allottees for certain funds appropriated for Chuuk and Kosrae States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 11-59, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 11-69 and 11-79, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
6 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
7 September 30, 2001, to provide funds for infrastructure and
8 other projects and programs in the State of Kosrae. The
9 funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as
10 follows:

 2 Public Laws Nos. 11-69, 11-79, 12-4 and 12-7, is hereby further amended
 3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 3. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof as may
 5 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
 6 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
 7 September 30, 2001, to provide funds for infrastructure and
 8 other projects and programs in the State of Chuuk. The funds
 9 appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as
 10 follows:

10 Section 3. Section 7 of Public Law No. 11-59, as amended by
 11 Public Laws Nos. 11-69, 11-79 and 12-7, is hereby further amended to
 12 read as follows:

13 "Section 7. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 14 date.

15 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
 16 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
 17 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
 18 Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds
 19 appropriated under subsection (1) of section 1 of this act
 20 shall be the Chairman of the Coordination Committee of the
 21 Kosrae State 2001 Summer Youth Conference. The allottee of
 22 the funds appropriated under subsections [~~(1)~~] (2), [~~(4)~~]
 23 (5) and (10) of section 1 of this act shall be the Secretary
 24 of the Department of Finance and Administration, or his
 25 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under

1 subsections (3) and (4) of section 1 and the funds
2 appropriated under section 6 of this act shall be the
3 Governor of the State of Kosrae, or his designee. The
4 allottees of the funds appropriated under subsections (6)
5 through (9) of section 1 of this act shall be the Mayors of
6 the respective towns or municipalities. The allottee of the
7 funds appropriated under sections 2 and 5 of this act shall
8 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, or
9 his designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
10 section 3 of this act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on
11 Improvement Projects⁺, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of the funds
12 appropriated under subsection (2)(b) of section 3 of this act
13 shall be the Vice President of the Federated States of
14 Micronesia, or his designee; and the allottee of the funds
15 appropriated under subsection (6)~~(d)~~ of section 3 of this
16 act shall be the Northwest Project Coordinator. The allottee
17 of the funds appropriated under subsections (1) through (13)
18 and subsection (15) of section 4 of this act shall be the
19 Governor of the State of Yap, or his designee. The allottee
20 of the funds appropriated under subsection (14) of section 4
21 of this act shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
22 Federated States of Micronesia, or his designee. The
23 allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that the funds
24 appropriated by this act, or so much thereof as may be
25 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this

1 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
2 sum appropriated.

3 (2) The authority of the allottees to obligate funds
4 appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30,
5 2002; EXCEPT THAT the authority of the allottee to obligate
6 funds appropriated under subsection (1) of section 4 of this
7 act shall lapse as of September 30, 2003 and the authority of
8 the allottee to obligate funds appropriated under subsection
9 (10) of section 1 of this act shall not lapse."

10 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
11 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
12 law without such approval.
