

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-100, as amended, by amending section 1 thereof to reallocate certain funds appropriated to the Northwest Islands in the State of Chuuk and by amending section 5 to change the allottee for such funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 10-1 and 10-116, is hereby further amended to read as  
3 follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,350,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General  
6 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
7 year ending September 30, 1997, for the purpose of funding  
8 the infrastructure, social and economic development and  
9 other needs of the State of Chuuk. The funds appropriated  
10 by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

4 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended by  
 5 Public Laws Nos. 10-20, 10-44, 10-73, 10-116, 10-117 and 12-8, is  
 6 hereby further amended to read as follows:

7 "Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
 8 date.

9 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
 10 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
 11 accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
 12 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
 13 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)  
 14 of section 1 of this act shall be the Governor of the  
 15 State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
 16 under subsection (2) (a), (2) (b), (2) (c) and (2) (d) of  
 17 section 1 of this act shall be the Teleisom Authority.  
 18 The allottees of the funds appropriated under subsection  
 19 (2) (e) and (2) (f), except for funds appropriated under  
 20 subsection (2) (e) (iv) and (2) (f) (iv), of section 1 of  
 21 this act shall be the mayors of the respective  
 22 municipalities. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
 23 under subsection (2) (e) (iv), (2) (f) (iv), (2) (g), (2) (h)  
 24 and (2) (i) of section 1 of this act shall be the mayor  
 25 of Polle Municipality. The allottee of the funds

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1           appropriated under subsection (3) of section 1 of this  
2           act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement  
3           Projects. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
4           subsections (4) and (8) of section 1 of this act shall  
5           be the Northern Namoneas Development Authority. The  
6           allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (5)  
7           of section 1 of this act shall be the Mortlock  
8           Development Authority. [~~The allottee of the funds~~  
9           ~~appropriated under subsection (6) (a) of section 1 of~~  
10          ~~this act shall be the Halls Project Coordinator. The~~  
11          ~~allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection~~  
12          ~~(6) (b) of section 1 of this~~  
13          ~~act shall be the Weito Project Coordinator. The~~  
14          ~~allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections~~

16          ~~Pattiw Development Authority.] The allottee of the  
17          funds appropriated under subsection (6) [~~(e)~~] of section  
18          1 of this act shall be the Northwest Islands Project  
19          Coordinator. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
20          under subsection (7) of section 1 of this act shall be  
21          the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of  
22          Micronesia or the Speaker's designee. The allottee of  
23          the funds appropriated under subsection (2) of section 2  
24          of this act shall be the Chairman of the Kosrae  
25          Utilities Authority, and the allottee of the funds~~



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1           appropriated under subsection (9) of section 2 of this  
2           act shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae. The  
3           allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
4           (1) (a) (i) of section 3 of this act shall be the Mayor of  
5           Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
6           under subsections (1) (a) (ii) a), (1) (a) (ii) b), and  
7           (1) (a) (ii) c) of section 3 of this act shall be the  
8           Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The allottee of the  
9           funds appropriated under subsection (1) (a) (ii) d) of  
10          section 3 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of  
11          Sokehs Municipality. The allottee of the funds  
12          appropriated under subsection (1) (b) of section 3 of  
13          this act shall be the Vice President of the Federated  
14          States of Micronesia or the Vice President's designee.  
15          The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
16          (2) (a) and (2) (b) of section 3 of this act shall be the  
17          Pohnpei Visitor's Bureau. The allottee of the funds  
18          appropriated under subsections (1) and (3) of section 4  
19          of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap.  
20          The allottee of all other funds appropriated by this act  
21          shall be the President of the Federated States of  
22          Micronesia or the President's designee. The allottees  
23          shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or  
24          so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for  
25          the purpose specified in this act, and that no

1 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
2 appropriated. The allottees of the funds appropriated  
3 under subsection (1) (a) and (1) (b) of section 3 of this  
4 act shall not obligate any funds appropriated therein  
5 without first consulting with the member of the Pohnpei  
6 Delegation to Congress representing the Election  
7 District to which the funds are apportioned. The  
8 allottees of funds appropriated under subsection (1) (a)  
9 of section 3 of this act shall not obligate or expend  
10 any funds apportioned under said subsection for travel.

11 (2) The authority of the allottees to obligate funds  
12 appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

13 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
14 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
15 becoming law without such approval.
