

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$9,420 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2003, to compensate certain employees in the Division of National Police for work done over and beyond their regular working hours during the period of September to November, 2002, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding section 509 of title 52 of the  
2 Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public  
3 Laws Nos. 10-62, 10-118, 10-151, 11-41 and 11-52, the sum of  
4 \$9,420, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby  
5 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of  
6 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2003, to  
7 compensate certain employees in the Division of National Police  
8 for work done over and beyond their regular working hours during  
9 the period of September to November, 2002.

10           Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
11 date.

12                   (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
13 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance  
14 with applicable law, including, but not limited to the Financial  
15 Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds appropriated

1 under this act shall be the President of the Federated States of  
2 Micronesia, who shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
3 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely  
4 for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations  
5 are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.

6       (2) The authority of the allottee to obligate funds  
7 appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 2003.

8       Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
9 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
10 becoming law without such approval.
