A BILL FOR AN ACT

All funds appropriated by this act shall be 17 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in 18 accordance with applicable law, including, but not 19 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. 20 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 21 (1) (a) of section 2 of this act shall be the PWP 22 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds 23 appropriated under subsections (1) (b) (i) through 24 (1) (b) (viii) of section 2 of this act shall be the 25 [Southern Namoneas Development Authority] Chuuk State

Office of Planning and Statistics. [The allottee of the 1 2 funds appropriated under subsection (1) (b) (vi) of 3 section 2 of this act shall be the Secretary of 4 Education of the Federated States of Micronesia]. 5 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 6 (1)(c) of section 2 of this act shall be the Lower 7 Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee of the 8 funds appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of section 2 9 of this act shall be the Northern Namoneas Development 10 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(e) of section 2 of this act shall be the 11 12 Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(f) of section 2 of 13 14 this act shall be the Saramen Chuuk Academy Board of Directors. The allottee of all other funds appropriated 15 16 under section 2 of this act shall be the President or 17 the President's designee; PROVIDED, the allottee of the 18 funds appropriated under subsection (3) of section 2 of 19 this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap. The 20 allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these 21 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used 22 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that 23 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 24 appropriated. The authority of the allottees to 25 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not

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lapse."
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         Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
 3 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
4 becoming law without such approval.
