#### PUBLIC LAW NO. 13-14

#### AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-100, as amended, by amending section 1 thereof, to reallocate funds appropriated for certain grants in the Southern Namoneas in the State of Chuuk, by amending section 6 thereof, to change an allottee of funds, to change the lapse date, and to remove a requirement for consultation with Members of Congress prior to obligating certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended by 1 Public Laws Nos. 9-104, 9-129, 9-150, 10-1, 10-116, 12-62 and 12-2 3 78, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 4 The sum of \$5,350,000, or so much thereof "Section 1. 5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for 6 7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, for the 8 purpose of funding the infrastructure, social and 9 economic development and other needs of the State of 10 Chuuk. 18	Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 9-100, as amended by
19	Public Laws Nos. 9-104 and 9-137, is hereby further amended to
20	read as follows:
21	"Section 5. All funds appropriated by this act shall
22	be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for
23	in accordance with applicable law, including, but not
24	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
25	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)

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1	of section 1 of this act shall be the Chuuk State
2	Commission on Improvement Projects. The allottee of
3	the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(a), (2)(b),
4	(2)(c) and (2)(d) of section 1 of this act shall be the
5	Toleisom Authority. The allottees of the funds
6	appropriated under subsection (2)(e) and (2)(f) of
7	section 1 of this act shall be the mayors of the
8	respective municipalities. The allottee of the funds
9	appropriated under subsection (2)(g), (2)(h) and (2)(i)
10	of section 1 of this act shall be the mayor of Polle
11	Municipality. The allottee of the funds appropriated
12	under subsection (3) of section 1 of this act shall be
13	the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
14	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections
15	(4) and (8) of section 1 of this act shall be the
16	Northern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee
17	of the funds appropriated under subsection (5) of
18	section 1 of this act shall be the Mortlock Development
19	Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated
20	under subsection (6) of section 1 of this act shall be
21	the Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of the
22	funds appropriated under subsection (7) of section 1
23	and subsection (2) of section 4 of this act shall be
24	the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
25	Micronesia or the Speaker's designee. The allottee of

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1	the funds appropriated under subsection (2) of section
2	2 of this act shall be the Chairman of the Kosrae
3	Utilities Authority, and the allottee of the funds
4	appropriated under subsection (9) of section 2 of this
5	act shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae. The
6	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
7	(2)(a) and (2)(b) of section 3 of this act shall be the
8	Pohnpei Visitor's Bureau. The allottee of funds
9	appropriated under subsections (1) and (3) of section 4
10	of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap.
11	The allottee of all other funds appropriated by this
12	act shall be the President of the Federated States of
13	Micronesia or the President's designee. The allottees
14	shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or
15	so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely
16	for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
17	obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
18	appropriated. The authority of the allottees to
19	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
20	September 30, 2003, except that the authority of the
21	allottee to obligate funds appropriated by subsection
22	(1)(c) of section 1 of this act shall lapse on
23	September 30, 2004."
