AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 13-36 to specify the use of certain funds appropriated therein, to change the allottee of certain funds, and for other purposes.

18	amended to read as follows:	
19	"Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse	
20	<u>date</u> .	
21	(1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,	mana
22	allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 1, 2	
23	and 3 of this act shall be the President of the	
24	Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, except	
25	that the allottee of the funds appropriated under	

subsections 1(1), 1(3) and 1(4) of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae; the allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 2(3) and 2(4) of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap; the allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 2(5) and 2(6) shall be the Speaker of Congress; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 3(2)(a)(i) shall be the mayor of Kolonia Town; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 3(2)(a)(ii), 3(2)(a)(iv) and 3(2)(a)(v) shall be the Sokehs magistrate; and the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 3(2)(a)(iii) shall be the mayor of Nukuoro. The allottee of the funds appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Projects, except that the funds appropriated under section 4(1)(c) of this act shall be allotted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia. (2) The allottees of the funds appropriated herein

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shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified herein, and shall report back to the Congress on the status of these funds no later than September 30, 2005. The authority of the allottees to

1	obligate such funds shall not lapse until fully
2	expended."
3	Section 6. This act shall become law upon approval by the
4	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
5	becoming law without such approval.
