A RESOLUTION

Requesting the Executive Branch of the Federated States of Micronesia to develop a Strategic Plan for the Prevention of Tobacco, Alcohol and Substance Abuse in this nation.

- 1 WHEREAS, there has been tremendous progress on tobacco,
- 2 alcohol and drug control by the Pacific Island Governments and
- 3 their civil societies; and
- 4 WHEREAS, experience has shown that there are many cost-
- 5 effective tobacco, alcohol and drug control measures that can be
- 6 used in different settings and can have a significant impact on
- 7 prevention; and
- 8 WHEREAS, studies show that more than 6.4 million children
- 9 living today will die prematurely because of a decision they will
- 10 make as adolescents, and intervention to prevent tobacco, alcohol
- 11 and drug use should begin at home and in schools; and
- WHEREAS, the projected health and economic consequences of
- 13 tobacco, alcohol and drug abuse on Pacific Island Governments and
- 14 their civil societies will be catastrophic; now, therefore,
- 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Thirteenth Congress of the Federated
- 16 States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 2004, that the
- 17 Congress hereby requests the President of the Federated States of
- 18 Micronesia to cause the Executive Branch to develop a
- 19 comprehensive strategic plan for the prevention of tobacco,
- 20 alcohol, and substance abuse within the Federated States of
- 21 Micronesia.
