- WHEREAS, to promote and rationalize the therapeutically sound
- 18 and cost-effective use of these drugs by health professionals and
- 19 consumers through the provision of drug utilization information,
- 20 training of health professionals in appropriate drug prescribing
- 21 and educating the public in drug use and storage; and
