A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by adding a new section 419 relating to the implementation of the Infrastructure Development Plan; and to further amend section 204 of Title 32 exempting such activities from the foreign investment and labor laws, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. A new Section 419 is added to chapter 4 of Title 2 55, as follows:
- 5 (1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the National Government shall have 6 7 jurisdiction, in coordination with the respective state, 8 over activities relating to any public contract that is 9 nor may be awarded for a civil works project to 10 implement any part of the Infrastructure Development 11 Plan and that is supported by funds provided through 12 Section 211 of the Amended Compact of Free Association, as that Plan may be amended from time to time, including 13 14 but not limited to all contract management activities, 15 all biding and pre-bidding procedures for such public 16 contracts, and all activities performed by any citizen 17 or noncitizaen contractor or subcontractor pursuant to

1 any such public contract. Except of this section, the provisions of chapter 4 shall not apply to public contracts referred to in this subsection. 3 4 (2) Notwithstanding section 205 of Title 32 of the 5 Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, no Foreign Investment Permit shall be required to conduct any 6 7 activity referred to in subsection (1). 8 (3) The provisions of subchapter III and subchapter IV 9 of chapter 1 of Title 51 shall not apply to alien workers employed exclusively on activities referred to 10 in subsection (1), and such workers shall not be deemed 11 nonresident for purposes of chapter 1 of Title 51. 12 13 (4) The President shall be responsible for 14 establishing procurement procedures specifically for use with all public contracts referred to in subsection (1), 15 16 which shall 17 (a) meet or exceed prevailing international 18 standards for free and open competitive bidding, 19 transparency, and fairness to all parties, (b) effectively and efficiently facilitate the 20 21 execution and implementation of public contract referred 22 to in subsection (1), 23 (c) protect resident workers, and 24 (d) protect the public interest.

Such procurement procedures shall take effect upon

adoption by the President in accordance with title 17 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia.

- (5) Any citizen taxpayer in the Federated States of Micronesia may seek to enjoin a public contract referred to in subsection (1) to the same extent and in the same manner as such remedy is available to bona fide unsuccessful bidders on the contract under the procurement procedures established and approved by the President pursuant to subsection (4).
- 10 (6) The courts of the Federated States of Micronesian 11 shall recognize and give full force and effect to the 12 dispute resolution methods established by the President 13 pursuant to subsection (4).
- Section 2. Section 204 of chapter 2 of the title 32 of the 15 Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as enacted by Public Law No. 10-49, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "Section 204. <u>Requirement that a foreign investor</u>

 18 <u>obtain a Foreign Investment Permit.</u>

A noncitizen may not conduct any activity in the FSM
that amounts to "engaging in business", as defined in
section 203 of this chapter, unless that noncitizen
holds a currently valid Foreign Investment Permit
authorizing that noncitizen to conduct that activity[-],
except as provided in section 419 of chapter 4 of Title
